# Choosing an Activity



## **Team goals**

Align the activity with the team goals. For example. if better communication is a team goal, choose an activity that will help the team improve its communications.



### **Team level**

Ensure the activity is appropriate for the team level. For a new team, one to help its members learn about one another. For an experienced team, one that challenges it.



### **Engagement level**

Irrespective of the potential of the activity, if it doesn't engage the team members they will turn off and the event will fail. Ensure the activity style will engage all.



# **Objectives**

Know what you want the time spent to deliver. Choose an activity that you can see how it will deliver your desired outcomes for the event.



# Debrief

Unless your only objective is for the people to have fun, you'll want a debrief. Choose a process that adds to the enjoyment and focuses on the learning aimed for.



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
